Life aboard is equally impressive. A Hurricane diesel hydronic heating system and full vessel Air Conditioning keeps the vessel comfortable in every season, while a Bromic Radiant heater on the aft deck extends your cruising season well into the shoulder months. The well-appointed galley features a premium Viking range, dual-drawer refrigeration, a dedicated deep freezer, and an additional freezer with an ice maker—ideal for extended cruising or entertaining aboard. A combination washer/dryer and Village water maker makes living aboard effortless.

The vessel has also benefited from a modern Furuno electronics suite, giving the next owner confidence with today's navigation technology. Whether making an overnight passage or exploring remote anchorages, you'll appreciate the redundancy, reliability, and ease of operation this yacht provides.
