The 2004 Meridian 411 Sedan Bridge is one of the most sought-after cruising yachts in her class, combining spacious accommodations, dependable Cummins diesel power, and exceptional comfort for extended cruising throughout the Pacific Northwest. Her wide beam, bright salon, two-stateroom/two-head layout, and expansive flybridge make her equally suited for entertaining or exploring destinations from the Gulf Islands to Southeast Alaska.

This Meridian has benefited from extensive recent maintenance and thoughtful upgrades, making her a truly turnkey opportunity. A 2026 marine survey is available on file, providing added confidence for her next owner.

Powered by twin Cummins 5.9B-TA 330 HP diesel engines with just over 3,500 hours, she offers economical, reliable cruising. A complete mechanical service was completed in June 2026, and an Onan 9kW generator with sound shield provides quiet, dependable onboard power while away from the dock.

Docking is made effortless with bow and stern thrusters, while an electric SeaWise davit system makes launching and retrieving the included 2017 Walker Bay 325 STX tender quick and convenient.

Major drivetrain maintenance was completed in 2026, including new PSS dripless shaft seals and new cutlass bearings. Engine cooling systems have also been updated with the aftercoolers and heat exchangers serviced in 2024.

Designed for true four-season cruising, the vessel is equipped with reverse-cycle air conditioning and diesel heat, ensuring comfort in any weather.

The helm has been modernized with Garmin 5200 multifunction displays at both the upper and lower stations, complemented by a Fusion Bluetooth stereo with flybridge controls.

Outside, the boat continues to impress with fresh bottom paint (June 2026), a professionally rebuilt and reinforced swim platform, an upgraded 25 kg Vulcan anchor, custom 48-inch trim tabs, and a new full flybridge enclosure installed in 2023, providing outstanding visibility and protection from the elements.
